


Very fine leaved dark green perennial rye grass

Blending extremely well with other fine species such as red fescues and bent grasses, Barsignum in a mixture will guarantee a superb aesthetic appearance.

Medium-dark colored leaves, being slightly darker than Bargold.

Partner varieties in mixtures

Barsignum was extensively tested in private trials at Hohenheim University in Germany. Due to the fineness of leaves Barsignum the trials in Germany showed up a perfect combination with all Festuca rubra species and with the finer leaved Poa pratensis varieties such as Barhelene.
